Three Well-Preserved Frames of Human Beings Dug Up On Burlington Island.

Bones Are Supposed, From Trinkets and Ornaments Found With Them, to be Skeletons of Delaware Indians, That Tribe Having Once Inhabited the Section.

Bristol, June 29.—Workmen at the island, while digging in the sand pits the other day unearthed three skeletons, all of which were in a perfect state of preservation.

A large quantity of bone ornaments and other trinkets were also found.

The latter suggest the inference that the ghastly find are the remains of the aborigines.

Many picnickers visited the place where the bones were unearthed and gazed with interest and curiosity upon the frames which once held erect the forms of a dignified trio of the noble red-men.
